

ACTION NOTES FROM BERA COMMITTEE MEETING on 13 July 2022 in the Sydney Gardens Community Pavilion

1. Charles welcomed those present to the first in-person BERA Committee Meeting since January 2020, in the new and very pleasant Sydney Gardens Community Building.
2. We would continue to press the CPT for a straight answer on the implications of recent press stories about the poor performance of Fusion Lifestyle at existing sites. Ric would reply to Manda on the optimum place for a cycle rack for Cleveland Pools customers.
3. * Wendy was coordinating the BERA response on our priorities for the BathNES Clean and Green scheme.
4. Our standard FoBRA team from now on would be Charles and Sally. We would focus there on practical issues with direct implications for our Estate.
5. The Swifts project was progressing well, but it was early days as it typically took some years for newly installed swift boxes to be occupied. Charles had offered to take over the leadership of the project after he stood down from the BERA Committee next April.
6. ** There had been a temporary improvement on tourist boat behaviour and speeds at the start of the season, but the problems had now returned.
7. Some street trees had been damaged by disease or white vans. Most would be replaced.
8. It was a shame that the Community Day did not attract enough support to go ahead. Some stalls were put up anyway. Residents had varying preferences on planning and spontaneity. We should consider trying again next year.
